YOUR ARRIVAL

When you arrive in the resort, you must first go to the «Salle des Quatre saisons», av. de l'Hippodrome to get your parking pass or rider pass. It must be affixed to the inside windows of your vehicle in order to access the competitors' parking areas and go through the police controls (only one pass by rider).

Schedule of parking pass withdrawal :

Thursday 2nd of february : 10am-7pm

Friday 3rd of february : 8am-7:30pm

Several car parks will be available for you to park for free on the day of the race or ahead of time for converted vehicles and camper vans. The car parks will open at 10am on thursday 2nd of february.

P1 : Thierry Sabine - 160 places

P2 : CHI - 370 places

P3 : Tir à l'Arc - 300 places

P4 : Hippodrome - 100 places

P5 : Airport (shuttles will be available to competitors near the parking area on saturday and sunday for free) - 170 places for riders of all races who stay outside of le Touquet.

Any rider who would park outside of these parkings will expose himself to a fine and his vehicle can be towed away.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CHECKS

The schedule change between the main race and the quad race, in order to manage timing regarding the tides, will have some consequences on the organization of the administrative and technical checks. The access to Le Touquet will be restricted on the Saturday so that it will be concentrated on 2 days only on Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd.

- Only riders of the main race and Vintage race will put their engines inside the riders area (place du marché couvert and place Edouard VII) directly after the checks. The riders of the Quads, Juniors and Espoirs categories will keep their engines after the checks and will put it in the riders area (Parking St Jean 2) on the morning of their race.
- The riders of the main race received a notification with a timing to respect for their administrative and technical checks, which will only take place on the Friday 3rd of February. The riders with a race number between 601 and 1310 will have to present themselves on the morning (between 8am and 12), the riders with a race number between 1 and 600 the afternoon (between 3:30pm and 7:30pm).
- The Vintage riders must go to the checks on Thursday 2nd of February from 1pm to 7pm.
- The Quad riders must go to the checks on Thursday 2nd of February from 5pm to 7pm or on Friday 3rd of February from 12 to 3:30pm.
- The young riders (Espoirs and Juniors) must go to the checks on Thursday from 1pm to 7pm or on Friday from 12 to 3:30pm.

We expect you to respect the time you'll be given. The late arrival won't be accepted and you risk the disqualification.



ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CHECKS

The Administrative and technical checks will take place at the Salle des Quatre Saisons, avenue de l'Hippodrome. You must come in person (you can come with only one assistant).

For administrative checks, you must bring :

- **ID card or passport.**
- For french riders, **2023 annual competition licence or one race licence.**
- For non-french riders, **Licence FIM EUROPE or FIM 2023** issued by their federation of origin accompanied by the « Start permission» to race at the Enduropale or one race licence issued by the FFM. If one race licence you will not need this authorization.
- **Medical certificate** of aptitude dated **less than one year** for riders taking a one race licence, stating that the holder has «**no clinical contraindication to the practice of motorbike sport including competition**». The originals of all documents must be presented. A template can be downloaded on **www.enduropaledutouquet.fr**

Please note that no exemption will be given for a passage to the administrative and technical checks on the day of the race.



ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CHECKS

Only one accompanying person by competitor is permitted during the checks. Under-16 (except for Espoirs and Juniors riders), animals, trots and bicycles are not allowed.

Each rider will get two wristbands for their assistants during the administrative checks. The assistants are not obliged to come in person. The wristband must be tightened to the wrist to access the riders' spaces and go through the safety controls. The extinguishers are compulsory at the pit stop. Unpredictable checks will be carried out throughout the weekend at the pit stop. Also for safety reasons, fire extinguishers will not be allowed in the technical and administrative checks.

If you prefer to take your one race licence directly on site, the FFM will charge you extra 10 €.



RIDERS AREAS AND PIT STOP

Riders areas will be located :

- Enduro Vintage : Place du Marché Couvert
- Enduropale Espoirs, Juniors, Quaduro : Parking St Jean 2
- Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais : Place du Marché couvert (1 to 600) and Place Edouard VII (601 to 1310)

Pit stop will be located :

- For all races : Parking St Jean 2
- Top riders Enduropale : by the second sea front patio

Some rules :

- Competitors must leave the park after their race
- Tents are not provided, competitors must share a 3mx3m space (2 assistants by rider maximum). For the riders who would have difficulties to find someone to share the space, please let a message on Engage Sport «discussion» section. You must put your race number on your tent.
- Once races are over, you must leave the pit stop area on foot, engine off. It is forbidden to take out gear during the race.
- Under 18 (except riders), animals, trots and bicycles are not allowed in the pit stop area.
- Considering the long distances on site, we advise you to bring your own transport equipment to carry your equipment from the parking area to the pit stop.
- Do not forget your extinguisher and environmental mat
- You will find a drop-off point on Quentovic parking, close to the pit stop area. CAREFUL, this drop off point is limited to 15 minutes and parking there is strictly forbidden. After 15 minutes, you'll have a fine and your vehicle will be removed. Also, only vehicles with a sticker will be able to access this area.

AREAS DEDICATED TO SPECTATORS

There will be areas dedicated to spectators on the beach and the sea front of Le Touquet-Paris-Plage and on the sea front of Stella Plage. The access to the beach between Stella Plage and Le Touquet-Paris-Plage will be strictly forbidden to the public for environmental reasons.

The Enduropale, a major sporting event, will not escape the constraints linked to the security of major events and the applicable health regulations. A large number of police and private security agents will be deployed throughout the town. A network of additional cameras will be installed and will provide a view of all areas that will be frequented by the public 24 hours a day.

We ask everyone to respect the posted municipal orders, the no entry areas and to agree to open your bags during eventual checks. Going inside the dunes and to the bottom of the dunes is strictly forbidden.

Furthermore, identity and wristband checks will be carried out during the weekend. Thank you for respecting the instructions so that this great sporting event takes place in the best conditions.

A Motorbike and motorcycle parking will be set up at the sea front. Driving visitors will have to park on the car park of the airport (10€ by car), which is opened on Saturday and Sunday. Free shuttles will take them into town.

The access to the PMA (medical area) is strictly forbidden for families except if accompanied by the organization.

WHERE CAN I GET BACK MY EQUIPMENT LEFT ON THE TRACK :

Motorbikes, clothes and helmets that have been found on the course are brought into the «Parc motos et quads cassés» located on St Jean 2 car park:

- Vintage until friday 4:30pm
- Espoirs until saturday 10:30am
- Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais until saturday 6:45pm
- Juniors until sunday 11am
- Quaduro until sunday 6:15pm

Then, for all races, the monday 6th of february, you will have to get back your equipment at the technical – avenue Georges Besse – Touquet between 8am and 5pm (from 10am for Quaduro). The equipment will be returned to the rider in exchange for the deposit ticket given by the pick-up truck or to the rider's assistance against presentation of an identity document and a photo.

Competitors are required not to leave their motorcycle or bike quads and equipment on the course. They must wait for the organisation vehicles roadside. The organisation is not responsible for any theft or loss.

ENTRANCE TO LE TOUQUET ON SATURDAY

Riders competing the main race Enduropale du Touquet Pas-de-Calais and Enduropale Espoirs with the wristband fasted around their wrist and the rider's pass given at the administrative checks stuck on the windsreen of their vehicles will be authorised by the police to enter Le Touquet after 7am on saturday morning. However, due to the heavy traffic, we advise you to arrive in the resort very early to avoid getting stuck in the traffic jam and missig the start of the race.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRACK

Be careful while driving over the second patio, the maximal height is 2m. The organisation cannot be held responsible for the loss of on-board camera such as go pro or any other equipment on the course during the race.



SOME OTHER VARIOUS POINTS

It is forbidden to drive with your machines on the sea front and in the town under penalty of a fine and exclusion for 2 years of our races.

The complete rules for each race are available on enduropaledutouquet.fr

We are expecting from all riders to communicate the information relating to their assistants on their Engage Sport profile in order to avoid any risk of not having access to the pit stop area.

It is strictly forbidden to replace another rider under penalty of exclusion of our races for several years.



OUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

Well aware of the current challenges, we have decided to commit ourselves to an eco-responsible approach.

MORE ECO-FRIENDLY BIBS

This year, our bibs will be made from ReEcofix material, 100% recycled polyester, 100% reusable. Riders who wish it can drop their bibs at the end of the race in a bin at the exit of the pit stop to recycle it. It will also be the case of the bibs non taken at the administrative checks.

SOFT MOBILITY

Implementation of a soft mobility for the spectators, riders, organisation :

- ➔ Creation of a motorcycle parking of 300 places on the sea front
- ➔ Segway for the organisation



OUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

- ➔ Partnership with the Regional council in order to offer to spectators trains at low prices and encourage them to use public transports, shuttles will drive them to the event
- ➔ Creation of a contest to reward virtuous spectators (see «practical informations» on enduropaledutouquet.fr)

WASTE SORTING

Waste dealing and sorting in the different areas, reduction of waste at the root, implementation of organic rubishes bins, limitation of the use of plastic in our various processes and paper (reduction of paper printing in favor of digital), essential printing only on recycled and recyclable paper.

BUT ALSO...

- Making our spectators and participants more aware and more responsible
- Promoting access of disabled persons via the PMR area which is dedicated to them and located on the seafront
- 20% reduction in organisation vehicles
- Parking area at the airport for traffic easing
- Realisation of impact studies, creation of dedicated zones for wildlife, preservation of the bottom of the Dunes
- Vote ashtray and distributor of pocket ashtrays - recycling of butts
- Creation of eco-friendly riders charts, spectators charts and shopkeepers chart



YOUR ECO-FRIENDLY COMMITMENTS

THE ECO-FRIENDLY RIDER'S CHARTER

As a race competitor, you are committing to :

- Do not drive with any motorised vehicles through the dunes area or on beaches along the whole coastline, except during the race (subject to expulsion from the race for 2 years in addition to penalties further to the official reports made by the competent authorities and the FFM)
- Do not use any tear off helmets and use an environmental carpet at the pit stop
- Do not throw rubbishes on the public domain, throw packaging in the provided containers and empty water bottles in the recycling bins
- Favour the public transports or care sharing to come to the race
- Drop off your bib inside the bin dedicated to the recycling of bibs at the pit stop if you don't wish to keep it. It will be recycled.
- Close the fuel tap of your engine in case of breakdown to avoid any leak of hydrocarbons on the beach.
